HIV/STD Surveillance

In order to prevent the spread of disease and improve health, North Carolina law requires that certain communicable diseases, including sexually transmitted diseases (STD), be [reported to local health departments](#). Timely and complete reporting helps ensure that prevention activities reach the right people. Good reporting also helps public health and community programs get needed resources. Reportable STDs include human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) infection, acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS), syphilis, gonorrhea, chlamydia and others. The local health departments report this STD information to the N.C. Division of Public Health's Epidemiology and Special Studies Unit (ESSU) which is part of the [HIV/STD Prevention & Care Branch](#). The ESSU combines the data into reports and provides this surveillance information to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) in Atlanta, Georgia. North Carolina data are available on this website. National information and statistics about STD and HIV/AIDS are available at the [CDC's website](#).
